



# Teach: Hub and Pathway Discipleship Plan



Let's create a comprehensive discipleship plan. This plan will include teaching elements only. During the Practice stage of the Generosity Cycle, you will have the opportunity to create experiential opportunities or events to help further develop the trait of generosity in the life of your people.

**1. Make a list of every teaching venue you can leverage during the course of a ministry year.**

Remember to include items like worship services, small groups, leadership training, and special events. Be age specific and comprehensive.

**2. Did your church utilize the Launch stage lessons entitled "Get Ready?"** This resource was previewed in the Launch stage of the Generosity Cycle. It was intended to help launch the digital giving platform along with the theme of generosity. There was no cost to these lessons. You may want to download and preview them.

**3. Has your church utilized the Generous Life series?** It was previewed during the Launch stage of the Generosity Cycle. You can download a free sample [here](#).

**4. Both the "Get Ready" and "Generous Life" series can be a regular part of your discipleship plan.** Decide if you would like to regularly or periodically offer these curricula.

**5. Review the Generosity Hub.** Respond to each question below for each spoke on the Generosity Hub.

- a. Do we have a venue where this topic is best being delivered?
- b. Is there a time of year when this topic is best delivered?
- c. Is there a ministry event/program we are already doing that will best support this topic?

**6. Your plan should address all categories in the Generosity Hub and develop every giver in the Generosity Pathway.** Allow yourself three years to accomplish this which should provide a solid learning pace for each giver.

Let's begin by simply planning the first year of teaching. Remember to be age specific. Then begin to complete the details of your plan. (*See example below.*) Remember the previous content you created throughout this stage of the cycle. It will help you complete your yearly calendar.

Feel free to customize this chart as desired to meet your specific needs. The objective is for your discipleship team to be confident that you have a one, two, or three-year teaching plan that adequately supports a well-rounded generous disciple of every age group and income level. You do not have to have a generosity themed opportunity every month. Feel free to utilize both large and small opportunities. For instance, the Offering Talk in worship and leadership devotions for Deacons/Elders Meetings should be a part of your plan. The theme of generosity needs to move from a special emphasis you engage here and there to a normal weekly cultural conversation like teaching on prayer, Bible study, or service.
